## Village News

**Bridge:** Canterbury Food Bank - Unfortunately, as St Peter's Church in Bridge remains closed, we are unable to receive donations for the Food Bank. However, non-perishable items may be donated at most major supermarkets as they now have collection points in store. As soon as we are advised it is safe to do so we will start collecting again in Church, we have been informed that we are one of their best regular contributors, well done St Peter's.

**Lower Hardres:** Hello from Lower Hardres. The Parish Council has circulated to every household a list of names and numbers to call if you need help with shopping etc. So far, there have not been many requests. Our local Farmshop has been wonderful, opening early for the elderly and putting orders together for people who cannot shop in person. The church yard seems to be a stopping off place for walkers as they follow the footpaths through our village, let hope some may return when the church re opens. The churchyard did look inviting with daffodils and blue bells but now it seems to be the weeds that are in abundance!

**Patixbourne:** St Mary's Patixbourne may be closed but work on the project to add an extension goes on. A digital survey was carried out in January, which has enabled our architect Andrew Clague to draw up some draft plans and 3D images of the proposed addition to the North side of the church. The new building is only small but includes a fully accessible toilet and shower, and a small kitchen. Inside the church we will remove pews at the rear of the north aisle to create a circulation space for refreshments after a service. This space can also be used as a sleeping area for pilgrims staying overnight at the church.
